Prayer shared by Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, asking maternal intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe

Holy Virgin of Guadalupe,

Queen of the Angels and Mother of the Americas.

We ask you to intercede for us with your Son,

**Pray for us, loving Mother,

Help us to bring the peace of Jesus to our land and to our hearts.
We come to you with confidence,
knowing that you truly are our compassionate mother,
health of the sick and cause of our joy.
Shelter us under the mantle of your protection,
keep us in the embrace of your arms,
help us always to know the love of your Son, Jesus. Amen**

How to make a Spiritual Communion

During this time, the faithful should be encouraged to make an act of spiritual communion. When unable to receive the Eucharist, one can pray for Jesus to enter their heart spiritually, that they may be filled with the graces they miss in the sacrament. A prayer attributed to Saint Alphonsus de Liguori is included below

**My Jesus,
I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there
and unite myself wholly to You.
Never permit me to be separated from You.
Amen. – Saint Alphonsus de Liguori**
