



Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office COVID-19 Update – October 19, 2020

EVANSVILLE, INDIANA – The Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office, which works with 26 diocesan Catholic schools across eight counties in Southwestern Indiana, provides the following summary for the time period between 2 p.m. CDT on Oct. 16 and 2 p.m. CDT on Oct. 19.

- **On October 19**, the Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office learned of 11 positive tests for COVID-19 involving nine students and two employees from a total of six diocesan schools. They include:
 - **School 1 – Three students tested positive**
 - **School 2 – Three students tested positive**
 - **School 3 – Two students tested positive**
 - **School 4 – One student tested positive**
 - **School 5 – One employee tested positive**
 - **School 6 – One employee tested positive**

The students and employees are self-quarantining, and will return to school at the appropriate time. The school administrations have contacted potential close contacts and asked them to self-quarantine. The school administrations also have notified school families and the staffs of the positive test. This information is not related to other positive tests previously reported.
