



Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office COVID-19 Update – October 26, 2020

EVANSVILLE, INDIANA – The Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office, which works with 26 diocesan Catholic schools across eight counties in Southwestern Indiana, provides the following summary for the time period between 2 p.m. CDT on Oct. 23 and 2 p.m. CDT on Oct. 26.

- **On October 26**, the Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office learned of nine positive tests for COVID-19 involving six diocesan Catholic schools. Six students and three employees tested positive during that time as follows:
 - School 1 Two students and one employee tested positive
 - School 2 Two students tested positive
 - School 3 One employee tested positive
 - School 4 One employee tested positive
 - School 5 One student tested positive
 - School 6 One student tested positive

The students and employees are self-quarantining, and will return to school at the appropriate time. The school administrations have contacted potential close contacts and asked them to self-quarantine. The school administrations also have notified school families and the staffs of the positive tests. This information is not related to other positive tests previously reported.
