



Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office COVID-19 Update – October 5, 2020

EVANSVILLE, INDIANA – The Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office, which works with 26 diocesan Catholic schools across eight counties in Southwestern Indiana, provides the following summary for the time period between 2 p.m. CDT on Oct. 2 and 2 p.m. CDT on Oct. 5.

- **From 2 p.m. CDT Oct. 2 until 2 p.m. CDT Oct. 5**, the Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office learned of eight positive COVID-19 tests involving students and employees from six diocesan schools. The breakdown includes:
 - **School 1** – One student tested positive and one employee tested positive
 - **School 2** – One student tested positive and one employee tested positive
 - **School 3** – One student tested positive
 - **School 4** – One student tested positive
 - **School 5** – One employee tested positive
 - **School 6** – One employee tested positive

The students and employees are self-quarantining, and will return to school at the appropriate time. The school administrations have contacted potential close contacts and asked them to self-quarantine. The school administrations also have notified school families and the staffs of the positive tests. This information is not related to other positive tests previously reported.
