## **Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office COVID-19 Update – November 23, 2020**

**EVANSVILLE, INDIANA** – The Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office, which works with 26 diocesan Catholic schools across eight counties in Southwestern Indiana, provides the following summary for the time period between 2 p.m. CDT on Nov. 20 and 2 p.m. CDT on Nov. 23.

- **On November 23**, the Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office learned of 15 positive COVID-19 tests involving 10 diocesan Catholic schools:
  - **School 1** – Four students tested positive
  - **School 2** – Two students tested positive
  - **School 3** – One employee and one student tested positive
  - **School 4** – One employee tested positive
  - **School 5** – One employee tested positive
  - **School 6** – One employee tested positive
  - **School 7** – One employee tested positive
  - **School 8** – One employee tested positive
  - **School 9** – One student tested positive
  - **School 10** – One student tested positive

The employees and students are self-quarantining, and will return to school at the appropriate time. The school administrations have contacted potential close contacts and asked them to self-quarantine. The school administrations also have notified school families and the staffs of the positive tests. This information is not related to other positive tests previously reported.
