Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office COVID-19 Update – January 11, 2021

EVANSVILLE, INDIANA – The Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office, which works with 26 diocesan Catholic schools across eight counties in Southwestern Indiana, provides the following summaries for the time period from 2 p.m. CST on Jan. 8 to 2 p.m. CST on Jan. 11.

- **On January 11**, the Diocese of Evansville Catholic Education Office learned of 18 positive COVID-19 tests involving seven diocesan Catholic schools:
 - **School 1** – Six students tested positive
 - **School 2** – Five students tested positive
 - **School 3** – Two employees tested positive
 - **School 4** – Two students tested positive
 - **School 5** – One employee tested positive
 - **School 6** – One student tested positive
 - **School 7** – One student tested positive

The students and employees are self-quarantining, and will return to school at the appropriate time. The school administrations have contacted potential close contacts and asked them to self-quarantine. The school administrations also have notified school families and the staffs of the positive test. This information is not related to other positive tests previously reported.
